Child Care Subsidy Information

- If your child / children fail to attend the first or last day of vacation Care the Government will remove CCS
- Child Care Subsidy is not eligible on excursions or surcharges (late pick up fee or enrolment fee)

Booking Information

- A 2024 enrolment form must be completed before the vacation care form is processed
- Completed forms or any changes are to be emailed to admin@mbcoosh.org.au (we will not accept bookings over the phone as per government regulations)
- Bookings will close Wednesday 25th of September 2024 at 5pm
- We have a 5-day cancellation period per booking, if you fail to contact us after the 5-day cancellation period, we will mark the child absent and the account will be charged for the booking (Public Holidays, weekends are not included in the cancellation period)
- If your child is unable to attend the session, please email us at admin@mbcoosh.org.au for the child to be marked absent
- All parents / guardians must provide the child's medication / medical equipment / action plan. OOSH centres will no longer be able to bring the child's medication or medical equipment to vacation care

Excursion & Big Day In Information

- All excursions require a separate form to be signed
- All children booked in for the excursion will be required to bring a wide brim hat, water bottle, morning tea, lunch, enclosed shoes appropriate clothes for jumping and climbing

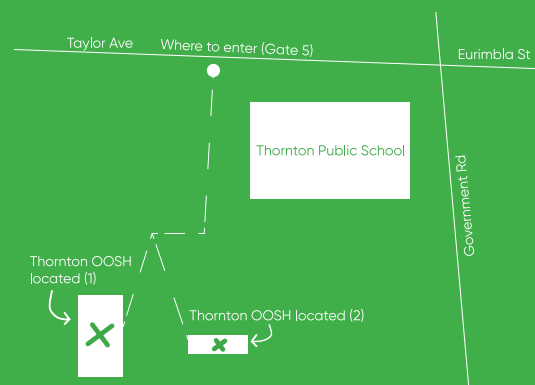

- I have agreed to the days of care & understand the service opens at 6:30am and closes at 6pm
- Bookings will be removed if the account is overdue. Parents / Guardians will be notified by email or phone if bookings are cancelled
- I am liable to pay fees for my child's care as indicated on this form and in line with other information the service makes available to me (such as a Fee Schedule) which are subject to change over time based on advice from the Provider
- Children that do not attend BSC/ASC must attend the first and last day of vacation care for (eligible) CCS to be applied to the account, as per government regulations. If my child fails to attend, I may be charged full fees
- Additional bookings can be requested if available. Additional booking requests must be in writing via email
- Parents / Guardians must provide 5 full working days in advance to cancel any bookings, if not the account will be charged for the booking. (Public Holidays, Weekends, and Day of Cancellation not included in notice period)
- Any changes to bookings will be subject to availability and are required to be made via email within 5 days notice (We will not accept any bookings via phone)
- (If your child requires any medication / medical equipment) I agree to provide the child's medication / relevant medical equipment / action plan
- I agree to not bring any animals on Vacation Care OOSH grounds
- The vacation care form must be completed and signed correctly by an authorised person for bookings to be processed
- If a hard copy of the Vacation Care form is submitted to the OOSH centres the form will take longer to be processed, and will delay the booking confirmation. This may result in missing out on bookings.
- Children will not be eligible to go on excursions if they have been recently suspended, absconded, or exhibited violent behaviours or had consistent incidents in the term/VC prior
- The details I have provided on this form are true and correct, and accept the above terms & conditions so that the service can receive eligible Child Care Subsidy on my behalf to reduce my fees

Return trip is in reverse order.
